

Information concerning the coronavirus, COVID-19

Flen Municipality is monitoring the development of the novel coronavirus and is working actively to ensure that the municipality's activities are impacted as little as possible in the event that infection spreads in Flen.

Flen Municipality is monitoring developments, remains in contact with the responsible authorities and is following their assessments and recommendations. Municipal administrations are continuously informed of the situation.

Flen Municipality are taking measures to minimise the spread of infection in Flen and to minimise the impact it will have on the municipality's activities as much as possible.

If you have been abroad in the last 14 days and have a fever or respiratory symptoms such as cough, shortness of breath or sore throat, you should **not** go directly to a health clinic. You should instead contact the Care Guide by phone at 1177 for information on what you should do next.
